SweetWater has consulted with the Grey Bruce Health Unit regarding health and safety during SweetWater Surreal Live. The following COVID-19 Safety Protocols will be enforced at all events:



**FEEL SICK  
STAY HOME**

If **feeling unwell or sick** (including symptoms such as fever, cough, difficulty breathing, sore throat, headache, fatigue, loss of taste or smell) **do not attend concert.**



**CONTROLLED  
ENTRY AND EXIT**

**Entry and exit from concert site will be done in a controlled fashion.** A distance of 2 metres from other audience members must be observed if waiting to exit or enter concert sites.



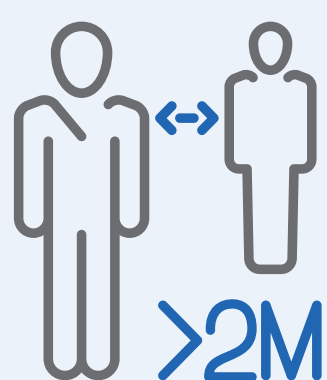
**USE  
FACE MASK**

**Face masks** must be worn (unless a health reason makes this problematic or children under 3) when entering, moving around, or exiting the concert site. They can be removed if sitting and distanced 2 metres from other patrons.



**MAXIMUM  
50 PEOPLE**

**A maximum of 50** concert attendees will be admitted during the concert.



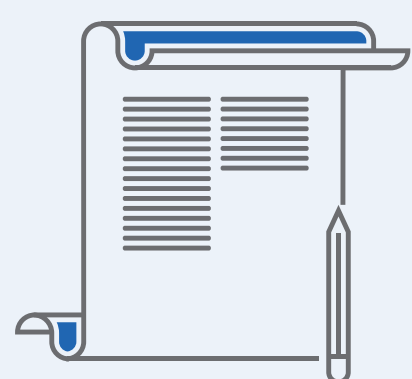
**KEEP YOUR  
DISTANCE**

**Physical distancing** (2 metres) is preferred during all times when possible. Each concert will have designated area for audience members to be set apart. Groups who are in the same "social bubble" can be seated together.



**MINIMAL  
CONTACT**

**Minimal physical contact will be enforced.** Registration and donation options that can be done online. Hand sanitizer is provided if any physical contact takes place (signing contact form, making a donation).
